CONGRESSIONAL LEGISLATION







Under current law, 63,000

military widows are penalized \$15,000 a year because military service caused their service member's death. This is called a "widow's tax" because, by law the VA annuity for the service-caused death is deducted from the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) annuity. Service members automatically receive SBP coverage for deaths on active duty. (Retiring personnel can also purchase SBP coverage to provide their spouses 55% of their retired pay.) MOAA is fighting to correct this injustice to widows and for many other earned benefits! —See www.moaa.com

LEGISLATION -STATE, CITY, COUNTY







Our Chapter and the MD Council of Chapters are fighting hard to achieve 100% tax exemption from MD state taxes for all uniformed services retirees. Recently, our chapter has contributed legislative support and economic analysis to pass legislation to achieve a \$15,000 MD state tax exemption for all age 55 and older in tax year 2018! --See www.starspan.org and lend your support to achieve 100% for all ages!

Maryland has approved a 20% property tax credit for five years for veterans and home owners over age 65 to be implemented by Counties and the City of Baltimore. Some counties in the Greater Baltimore area are pursuing this benefit for veterans! We need to support this effort in all counties and Baltimore City!
