CONGRESSIONAL LEGISLATION





Under current law, 63,000 military widows are penalized \$15,000 a year because military service caused their service member's death. This is called a "widow's tax" because, by law the VA annuity for the servicecaused death is deducted from the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) annuity. *Service members automatically receive SBP coverage for deaths on active duty*. (Retiring personnel can also purchase SBP coverage to provide their spouses 55% of their retired pay.) MOAA HAS CORRECTED this injustice to widows and many other earned benefits in the 2020

Maryland has approved a 20% property tax credit for five years for veterans and home owners over age 65 to be implemented by Counties and the City of Baltimore.
